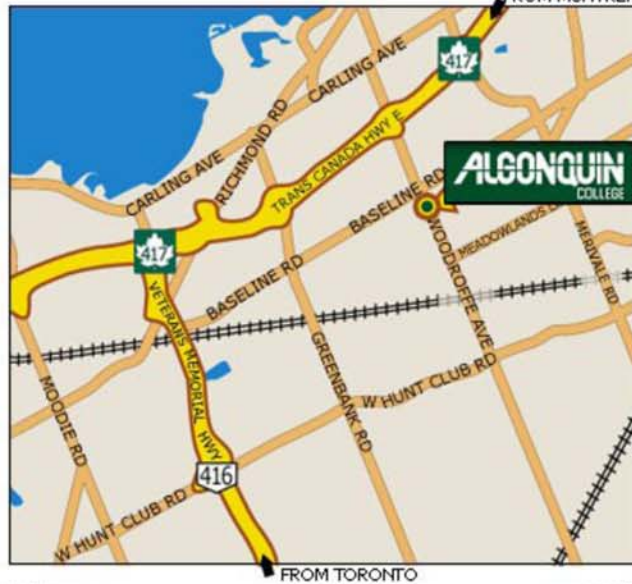

Accommodation

The residence is 100% smoke free and provides continental breakfast, wired high speed internet access, local call, parking and Cable television as part of the cost of the room. Event Food

Catering for the event is provided by Algonquin College Catering. For the Convention, the following catering services are being used:

Residence Building - Continental Breakfast for walkers staying at the residence, serve in the Lobby between 7-9 am.

Meet and Greet - A summer barbeque on the teachers' patio will consist of hamburgers, vegetable tray, potato chips and soft drinks. Other beverages will be available at a modest cost.

Banquet - The dinner will include assorted artisan breads rolls with butter, relish trays, garden vegetable salad, creamy potato salad, devilled eggs, fusilli pasta salad and Italian inspired cold meat platter. The main course features carved hip of beef au jus and a selection of chicken coq au vin or smoked mozzarella ravioli with mascarpone tomato cream. Accompanying the main course are roasted Parisian potatoes, steamed vegetables, a domestic cheese tray and fresh fruit platter. Followed by assorted cakes and pastries with coffee and tea. There will be wine with dinner and a bar will be available.
